Q8. Do you like working at a cafe, or do you find it too distracting?

Role-play

Useful Expressions for the Role-play

Topic 2: Music



Q1. What kind of music are you into these days? Who is your favorite artist?

Q2. When and where do you usually listen to music?

Q3. How has your taste in music changed over the years? What did you listen to in the past?

Q4. How do you usually find new music or artists to listen to?

Q5. Have you ever been to a live concert or a music festival? Tell me about that experience.

Useful Expressions for the Questions

Eclectic taste: 취향이 폭넓은	Lift my mood: 기분을 북돋다
Be into something: ~에 빠져 있다	Reminisce: (추억을) 회상하다

Topic 2: Music



Q6. Tell me about a time when you heard a song that really moved you or reminded you of a special memory.

Q7. Some people prefer listening to music at home, while others love going to live shows. What are the advantages of each?

Q8. How do you think technology (like streaming apps or AI) has changed the way we enjoy music?

Role-play

I am your friend. I just found out that our favorite singer is having a concert next month! Call me to talk about the concert and decide which tickets we should buy.

Useful Expressions for the Role-play

Topic 3: Housing

Q1. Can you describe your current home? What is your favorite room or corner in your house?

Q2. What do you like most about your neighborhood? Is it convenient or peaceful?

Q3. How do you usually spend your time when you are at home?

Q4. What is your daily routine when you wake up in the morning?

Q5. Have you ever had any problems or issues with your house, like a leak or something broken? How did you fix it?

Q6. Tell me about the first time you moved into your current place. Do you remember how you felt on that day?

Q7. Some people prefer living in a big city, while others like the countryside. Which one do you prefer and why?

Q8. If you could renovate one thing in your house, what would it be?

Role-play

I am a real estate agent. You are looking for a new apartment. Call me and ask at least three questions about the rent, location, and the number of rooms.

Useful Expressions for the Role-play

How far is it from the station?	When can I move in?

Topic 4: Parks

Q1. Can you describe a park that you often visit?
What does it look like, and where is it located?

Q2. What is the overall atmosphere of that park? Is it usually crowded or quiet?

Q3. What do you usually do when you go to the park?
Who do you usually go with?

Q4. Walk me through your typical visit to the park from beginning to end.

Q5. Tell me about a memorable or unexpected thing that happened to you at a park.
