Ice Breaking

Q1. How are you feeling today?

오늘 기분이 어떠신가요?

TIP: Show a positive and calm attitude.

Avoid negative words and keep your tone bright.

Sample answer:

I'm a little nervous, but I'm really happy to be here today.

I've been looking forward to this interview.

Q2. What time did you wake up this morning?

오늘 몇 시에 일어나셨나요?

TIP: Answer naturally and show good time management.

No need for detailed explanations.

Sample answer:

I woke up at 7:00AM this morning because I didn't want to rush. I wanted to start the day calmly.

Q3. Did you have breakfast this morning?

아침 식사는 하셨나요?

TIP: Give a light and positive response.

Energy and readiness matter more than the food itself.

Sample answer:

Yes, I had a banana and yogurt since it's light and easy to digest, and it helped me stay focused for the interview.

Q4. How did you get here today?

여기까지 어떻게 오셨나요?

TIP: Show that you arrived smoothly and on time. Emphasize reliability and planning.

Sample answer:

I took the bus today. I got off one stop early and walked here to calm myself and clear my mind.

Q5. What is your hobby?

취미가 무엇인가요?

TIP: Mention a hobby that reflects your personality or lifestyle. Briefly explain how it helps you relax or recharge.

Sample answer:

I enjoy running. It helps me clear my mind and manage stress, so I usually go running at least three times a week.

Q6. What are you planning to do after the interview?

면접이 끝난 후 무엇을 할 예정인가요?

TIP: Share a light and positive plan that shows energy and balance. Avoid answers that sound tired or negative.

Sample answer:

My friend is coming to Seoul today, so we decided to meet and have lunch together. I'm looking forward to it.

Q1. Tell me about yourself.

자기소개 해주세요.

TIP: Give a brief overview of who you are and connect it naturally to why you fit the cabin crew role.

Sample answer:

My name is , and I recently graduated with a degree in tourism management. I would describe myself as a calm and people-oriented person who enjoys working with others. During my studies, I often worked in team-based environments, which helped me develop strong communication skills. These experiences made me realize that I enjoy supporting people and staying composed in different situations, which is why I believe the cabin crew role suits me well.

Q2. What is your name, and what does your name mean?

TIP: Keep it personal but simple. Use the meaning to show a positive value or personality trait.

Sample answer:

My name is Ji-eun. The meaning of my name is 'wisdom and kindness.' I think it reflects my personality quite well because I try to stay thoughtful and considerate toward others. Whether in daily life or group situations, I naturally pay attention to how people feel.

Q3. Why do you want to become a cabin crew?

TIP: Focus on one clear reason
and explain it with a real experience or realization.

Sample answer:

I want to become a cabin crew member because I enjoy working with people in service-oriented environments.
Through my part-time work in customer service, I learned that I feel fulfilled when I can help others feel comfortable and supported. I also admire how cabin crew members stay calm and professional in various situations. That balance of service, responsibility, and teamwork is what truly attracted me to this role.
